Original instructions: Cross Hands-back again-lead down the Middle, then turn your Partner up again, and cast off-the Gent.casts off one Co.to the Ladies Side, and the Lady to the Gent.Side-balance all six-set, and go all round-second and third Co.balance in the Middle, opposite to each other-then Half right and left in the Middle.

three-couple longways

- A1 Couples 1&2 R&LH star as couple 3 R&LH turn.
- A2 Couple 1, giving inside hand, lead down (4), wheel round, man backtracking, to face up, dance back and cast to middle place improper, couple 2 leading up.
- B1 Take hands in lines of 3: go forward and back.
- B2 Join hands-6 and circle L halfway round.
- C1 All set R&L to partner. Couple 1 cast to the bottom <u>as</u> the tops face down, the bottoms up, and those two couples set R&L on the line, moving forward to meet.
- C2 <u>As</u> couple 1 two-hand turn in bottom place, the others do two changes of rights and lefts, beginning with neighbour on the line, all ending proper and progressed (231).

Notes

- 1. The original was a triple minor longways. I have added movements for couple 3 in A1, and for couple 1 at the end of C2.
- 2. B1 was a balance twice to partner.
