


Up Tails All

G C D G Em D G Em Am D D7 G (13x)

Lead in all a D. and back again, set and turn S. ☺ That again ☺

First Cu. lead through the 2. Cu. cast off and meet within, clap hands and Arms ☺ And so forward to the next, the rest following in order ☺

First Cu lead through the 2. cast off and meet within, clap hands all four, hands a cross all four, and round to your places, and so forward, &c.

First Cu. lead through the 2. Cu. cast off and meet within, clap hands all four, and hand round all four to your places, and so forward &c

square set, numbered anti-clockwise

Introduction: Take hands-8: go into the middle and fall back. Partners set R&L, moving forward and acknowledging, and turn single R to place. Do all that again.

Figure 1: Couple 1 move to the R to face couple 2, lead between them, separate, and cast back to face them again. Both couples clap on beat 8, and opposites arm R. Couple 1 repeat the figure with couples 3&4 in turn, and fall back to place.

Figure 2: As couple 1 are moving on to couple 4, couple 2 move to their R to face couple 3, leading between them as in the preceding figure. Both couples clap and RH star. Couple 2 repeat the figure with couples 4&1, and fall back to place.

Figure 3: As couple 2 are moving on to couple 1, couple 3 move to their R to face couple 4, and lead between them. Both couples clap, and opposites back to back. Couple 3 repeat the figure with couples 1&2 in turn, and fall back to place.

Figure 4: As couple 3 are moving on to couple 2, couple 4 move to their R to face couple 1, and lead between them. Both couples clap, and circle L. Couple 4 repeat the figure with couples 2&3 in turn, and fall back to place.

Finale: Repeat the introduction.

Notes

1. The original was a round for as many as will, numbered clockwise.
2. I have given each figure to a different couple, overlapping the figures, and adding back to back for couple 3.
3. The introduction has been repeated as an ending.
4. If the dance is repeated, it is recommended that the set should circle R one place and renumber to avoid monotony.
