

WE'LL DANCE AGAIN

Duple Proper Contra

- A1 Up the hall 4-in-line (ones in center), ones turn as a couple (8)
Return improper and hand cast to form a ring (8)
- A2 Balance the ring (4)
Neighbors roll away with a half sashay (rolling right to left) (4)
Right-hand dancers chain across (8)
- B1 Same two do-si-do (6)
Partners swing (10)
- B2 Taking hands in a ring, balance and spin to the right (as in Petronella) (8)
Ones: cross down between current neighbors, then *down outside the next*, arriving between these new neighbors to form a new line-of-4 facing up (8)

From the Author:

We'll Dance Again was written in May 2020. As a lover of both the chestnuts and the recent flourishing of new contra choreography, I tried to make a dance that reflects both, and would be appealing to dancers across generations. This also felt right given the dance's title. I've notated it without reference to gender roles.
